

Artists Space Information Page

Creative Kids Museum will provide a full contract which will elaborate on the following items. Briefly the conditions of the agreement will be as follows:

Creative Kids Museum will consider the Artist as a contract worker.

- The Artist will be covered for *liability insurance* by TELUS World of Science – Calgary.
- *Statutory remunerations*, workers compensation etc. shall be the responsibility of the Artist.
- *Intellectual property* rights remains with the Artist. TELUS World Science - Creative Kids Museum reserve the use of the photos of artworks for promotional purposes only.
- *Indemnity*: the Artist shall indemnify TELUS World Science - Creative Kids Museum it's visitors, employees from all damages, expenses, losses and costs of any kind.
- An *honorarium* will be offered commensurate with Artist's experience.
- Should either party need to break the contract two weeks notice will be required.

What Creative Kids Museum will provide for the Artist

- Approximately 700 square foot space, concrete floor, 2 walls painted dry wall, 2 walls metal panels.
- 1 folding table, 1 chair, 1 locking - storage cabinet
- Water is in a kitchen sink nearby, electricity
- Garage door size load in is nearby, 1 free parking pass
- Natural light is from high windows.
- A half wall and doorway separates space from public. There is no locking capability for the space from the rest of the exhibit hall.
- Featured on TELUS World of Science/Creative Kids Museum website under programming.

What the artist agrees to

- Set up and take down on the agreed dates. Proposed term is four months.
- Return space as it was found – deducting wear and tear.
- Spend a minimum of four hours a day for five days of a week working in the space. The museum's hours of operation are 9:30 am – 4:00 pm. working outside of these hours can only be by special arrangement.
- Spend a minimum of the equivalent of a thirty minute block daily dedicated to working with, speaking to or demonstrating to the museum guests. (Primary audience 4-13 years old)
- Use no aerosol paint sprays, spray varnishes, fixatives, noxious fumed substances that might interfere with our visitor's health or comfort.
- Keep the space presentable and safe for public viewing.
- Not to sell work from the space – giving out information about your own work is fine.
- A Police information check will be required from all artists.

An advisory committee will review proposals. Successful applicants will be notified.
